



ART TORONTO ANNOUNCES EXHIBITORS FOR 2018 EDITION

Toronto, ON (July 17, 2018) – Art Toronto is proud to announce the participating galleries for 2018. The 19th edition of Canada's fair for modern and contemporary art will include 102 exhibitors from seven countries and 28 cities. The fair will be organized in four sections: MAIN, SOLO, VERGE and FOCUS.

Art Toronto will be held at the Metro Toronto Convention Centre from October 26-29, 2018. The Opening Night is on October 25th and is a benefit gala for the Art Gallery of Ontario (AGO).

The established **MAIN** section includes more than 70 premier modern and contemporary galleries from Canada, the United States, Germany, United Kingdom, Argentina, Israel and Belgium. Art Toronto is pleased to introduce **GOLESTANI** (Dusseldorf), **Hosfelt Gallery** (San Francisco) and **Project Gallery** (Toronto) to the fair along with its many returning galleries for 2018.

The **VERGE** section is dedicated to galleries that have been in business for eight years or less, presenting work by young and emerging artists made in the past five years. This year Art Toronto welcomes **Projet Pangée** from Montreal and **DNA Gallery** from London, Ontario.

The **SOLO** section includes 12 galleries, each presenting a highly-curated body of work by a single artist.
